3. **Bluewater Council Election Results**

Councillor-at-large Jim Fergusson (Houston Heights South shoreline subdivision) was elected.

Fergusson received 2,261 votes; Laporte - 885; Harburn - 637. Jim's broad support across the

entire Municipality is demonstrated by the fact that he received more votes than each of his

opponents in all three ward groupings – shoreline; village wards; and the two rural wards.

He led the polls in five of the seven wards. The obvious factors contributing to Jim's victory:

a strong, credible candidate; a good campaign; **BSRA endorsement and publicity**; and **overwhelming shoreline support** (86.8% of the votes in Hay West and Stanley West Wards).
